

BID programme agreement

Agreement between Auckland Council and Heart of the City Inc.

Business Association Business Improvement District (BID) Programme Agreement

Heart of the City (the business association) is registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 and undertakes business-led programmes initiated by the local business community, which promote and develop its local business economy. Auckland Council recognises the role the business association has in contributing to the economic development of local communities and the region as a whole. Auckland Council wishes to work with the business association to establish and implement the BID programme.

In signing this agreement, the parties agree to the following in order to achieve the aims of the BID programme:

1. The parties agree to work together under the BID Policy (2016).
2. The business association agrees to comply with all aspects of the BID Policy (2016).
3. The business association agrees to manage the strategic and operational business of the association to a professional standard.
4. Auckland Council agrees to consider the incorporation of the BID targeted rate amounts into the Auckland Council Annual or Long-term Plan.

Auckland Council is obliged by virtue of being a local government organisation to:

- a. Observe due process, and comply with its policies; and
- b. Comply with various statutes such as the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 and the Public Records Act 2005.

Accordingly, Auckland Council's obligations under this agreement are subject to Auckland Council's processes, policies and legislative obligations. Nothing in this agreement creates any partnership obligations between the parties. Subject to any variation, this agreement will start on the date it has been signed by both parties and will continue until 30 October 2019. A party may terminate this agreement by 3 months' written notice to the other party.
