Auckland is once again proud to host **IRONMAN 70.3 Auckland** on **Sunday 19 January 2014**. IRONMAN 70.3 Auckland is an endurance triathlon event which will take place in and around Auckland's waterfront precinct.

Around 1300 local, domestic and overseas competitors will compete in this international event, which doubles as the IRONMAN 70.3 Asia Pacific Championship. The Event Village is the Viaduct Events Centre and Wynyard Quarter area, and the course will have athletes completing a 1.9km swim in the Viaduct Harbour, a 90km bike ride, which includes the Auckland Harbour Bridge, and a 21.1km run along the waterfront, finishing at the Viaduct Events Centre.


