CITYWATCH

CityWatch, a partnership between Auckland Council and Heart of the City, supports a safe and inviting city centre. The on-street CityWatch team can help address issues such as obstruction to businesses and public spaces, anti-social behaviour as well as monitoring busking, outdoor trading, illegal dumping and damage to public assets.

If someone is causing nuisance or acting inappropriately in a public place, call **Auckland Council on 09 301 0101** to log a job for CityWatch to attend.
For more serious concerns, call 111.

POLICE: CRIME PREVENTION

The NZ Police aim to prevent crime before it happens, ultimately making Auckland city centre a safer and better place to live, work and visit. Crime prevention programmes include StoreWatch. Police also provide advice to businesses on how to prevent crime, retail theft and increase safety. Their active policing includes on-street presence in the city centre. They also work alongside the CityWatch team to support a safe city centre.

Heart of the city can facilitate safety specific enquiries from business.

STOREWATCH

StoreWatch, a communication network of 150+ businesses and the NZ Police, aims to reduce and prevent retail theft in the city centre. The network shares critical information, including suspicious behaviour and shoplifting incidents. This information helps police make arrests and grows awareness and a sense of community between participating businesses.

TRESPASS

Businesses can verbally trespass or issue a written trespass notice to anyone who is not wanted in their store. CCTV images or mobile pictures of the person including date, time and reason for trespass is useful as it can be used as evidence.
