GETTING RUBBISH AND RECYCLING COLLECTIONS RIGHT



At the right time Mon - Sat from 5pm - 5.30pm and 12am (midnight) - 4am Sun from 12am (midnight) - 4am



In the right place

At the kerbside, not blocking the footpath, doorways or litter bins



In the right bag

Official orange (rubbish) or clear (recycling) Auckland Council bags only. Cardboard doesn't go in a bag. Cardboard should be flattened and bound with string or placed inside another box.



With the right contents

No more than 15kg, free of hazardous materials, garden waste or liquids
