Auckland Transport (AT) is responsible for all of the region's transport services (excluding state highways) – from roads and footpaths, to cycling, parking and public transport.

Auckland Transport (AT) will be carrying out road maintenance work along Queen Street and Wellesley Street, Auckland.

This involves road resurfacing and digging out a section of the carriageway

This work will be undertaken in the below areas:

Area 1 – Queen Street between Wakefield Street and Mayoral Drive and a section in the bus lane near bus stop 7056 / 330 Queen Street. Shown in red over page.

Area 2 – Queen Street (northbound lanes) between Wakefield Street and Wellesley Street West, including the intersection of Queen Street and Wellesley Street West. Shown in green over page.

Area 3 – Queen Street (southbound lanes) between Wellesley Street East and Wakefield Street, and some sections of Wellesley Street East. Shown in blue over page.

To minimise disruption to businesses work will take place during the day and night.

While this work is underway, large machinery will be operating in the area resulting in an increase in noise, dust and vibration. Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum.


Road resurfacing details follow:

Dates	Area 1 – 7am on Sunday 29 December to 6am Monday 30 December (day and night work).
	Area 2 – 5pm Monday 30 December to 6am Tuesday 31 December.
	Area 3 – 5pm Thursday 02 January to 6am Friday 03 January 2020.
	In the event of unforeseen circumstances a contingency date of Sunday 05 January 2020 is available.
Temporary Traffic Management	Temporary traffic management will be in place and will change for each shift. Resident and business access will be maintained.
	Area 1 – A road closure will be in place along Queen Street between Wakefield Street and Mayoral Drive. Traffic along Queen Street (between Wellesley Street and Mayoral Drive) will flow southbound. Access to Wakefield Street will be restricted from Mayoral Drive.
	Area 2 –Traffic along Queen Street (between Wellesley Street and Mayoral Drive) will flow southbound only. From 9pm, Wellesley Street West between Albert Street and Queen Street will be closed. Access to Queen Street from Mayoral Drive will be restricted. Detours will be in place.
	Area 3 - Traffic along Queen Street (between Wellesley Street and Mayoral Drive) will flow southbound only. From 9pm, Wellesley Street East between Mayoral Drive and Queen Street will be closed. Access to Queen Street and Wakefield Street from Mayoral Drive will be restricted. Detours will be in place.
	During work hours traffic controllers will be on site to assist pedestrians and vehicles where required. Stop/go operations will be in place at times. Please allow extra time when travelling in the area.
Street Parking	One day prior to work starting, cones and no parking signs will be placed on site and remain in place until work is complete. Please park off street and away from the work area until traffic management has been lifted.
Driveway / Property Access	When we are resurfacing, please expect some delays while machinery is working near your driveway. To access properties within the work area, traffic controllers will be onsite to safely guide you across the site.
Pedestrian Access	Business and pedestrian access will be maintained. Please take care when out walking in the area.
Bus stops	During work hours only, bus stops near the work area may closed and a temporary bus stop provided. Please allow extra time and plan ahead.
