Wage Subsidy Supports employers to pay their employees when they are impacted by an Alert Level setting of 3/4 for 7 days or more, with at least 40% downturn over 7 days	More detail and apply at workandincome.govt.nz/covid- 19/wage-subsidy
Resurgence support payment Support to aid meeting one-off costs or impacts to cashflow when Alert Levels change. Firms that experience a 30% drop in revenue over a 7-day period will be eligible	More detail and apply at ird.govt.nz/rsp
