It will showcase over 50 vibrant art and lighting installations across the city centre – forming an immersive trail to encourage people to rediscover the city at all times of the day and night. City of Colour is a partnership between Heart of the City, Auckland Council and other major city centre stakeholders.

Installations will be located all around the heart of the city - including the Viaduct, Britomart, Te Komititanga, Aotea Square, Vulcan Lane, Freyberg Square, Fort Street, Queen Street and more. Significant landmarks and buildings will also be lit up to add to the atmosphere – including the Town Hall, The Civic, Sky Tower, Vector Lights on the Harbour Bridge, Lightship on Bledisloe Wharf and more. There will also be street banners promoting the event from Mid-April.
