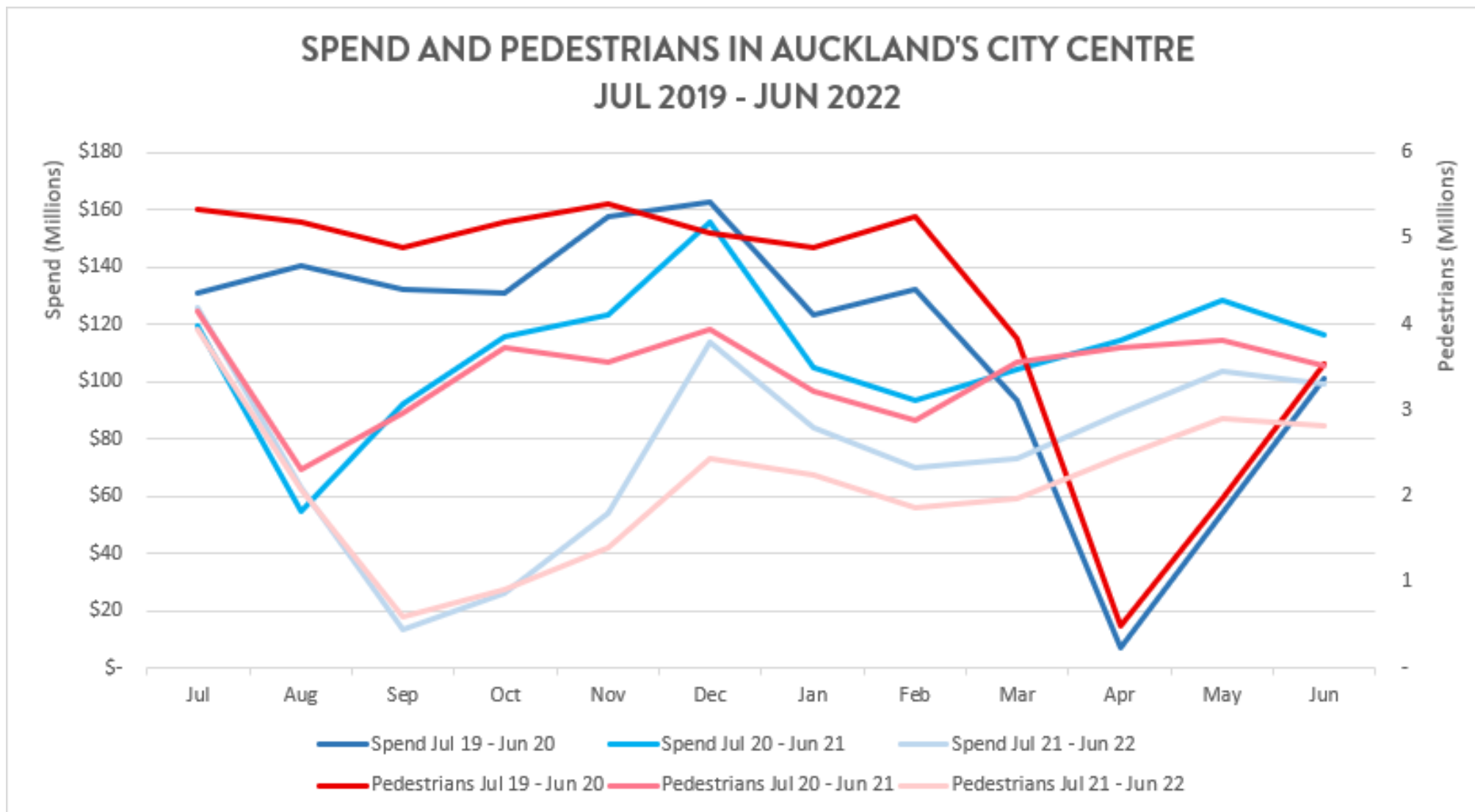


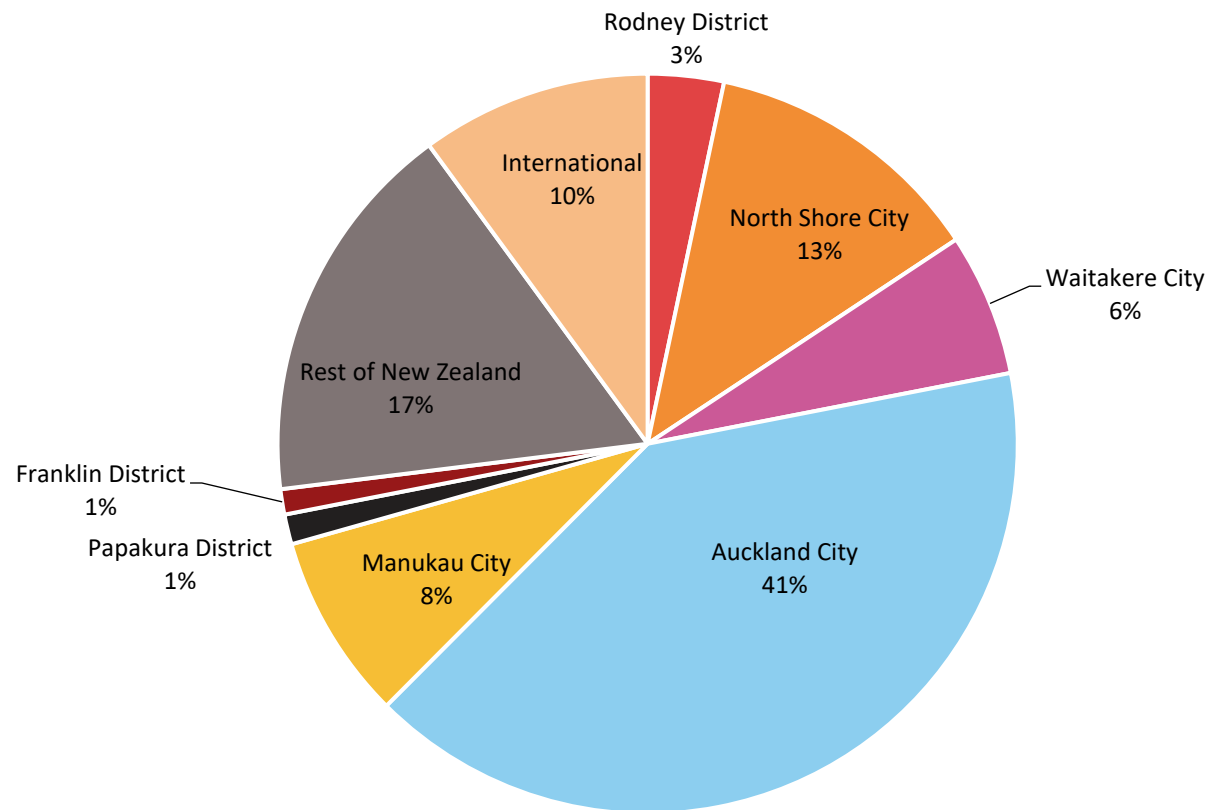

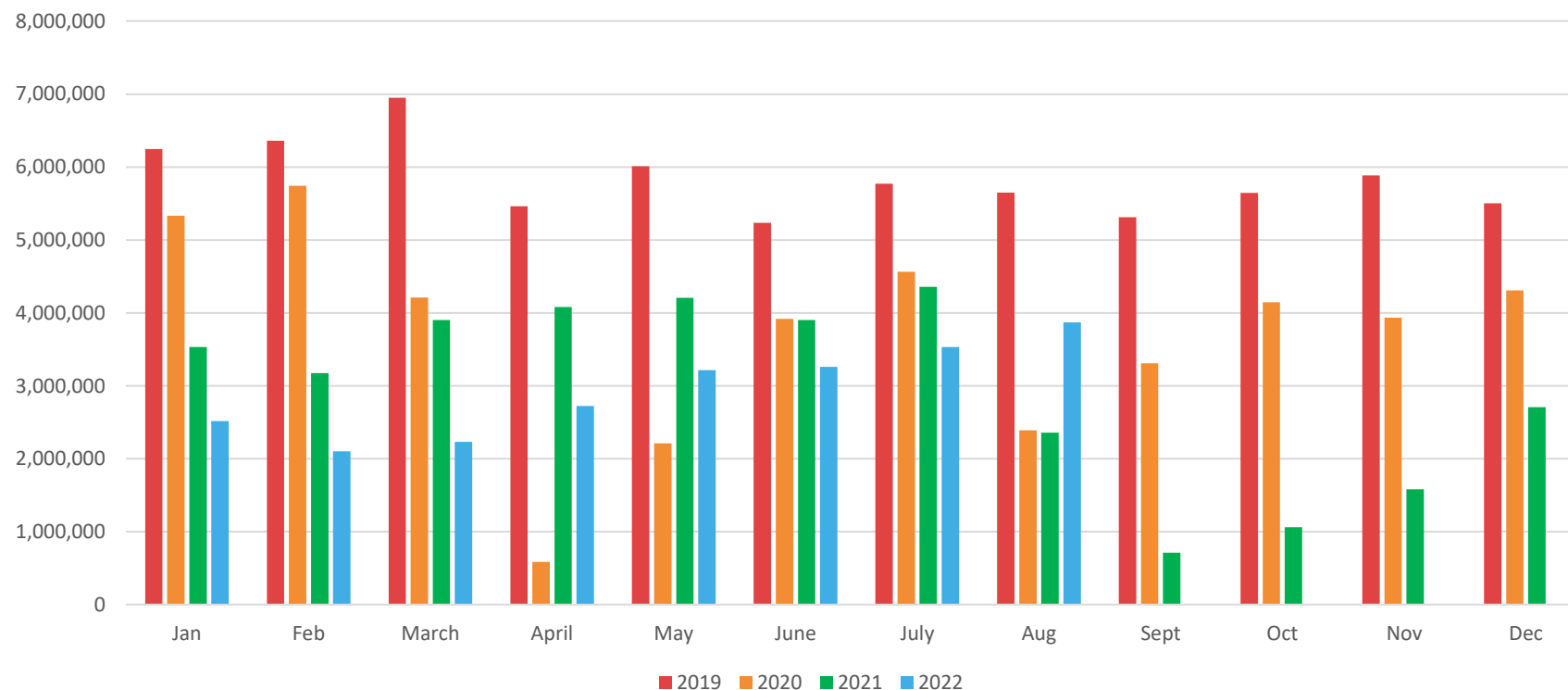

Monthly ped counts - 4 year

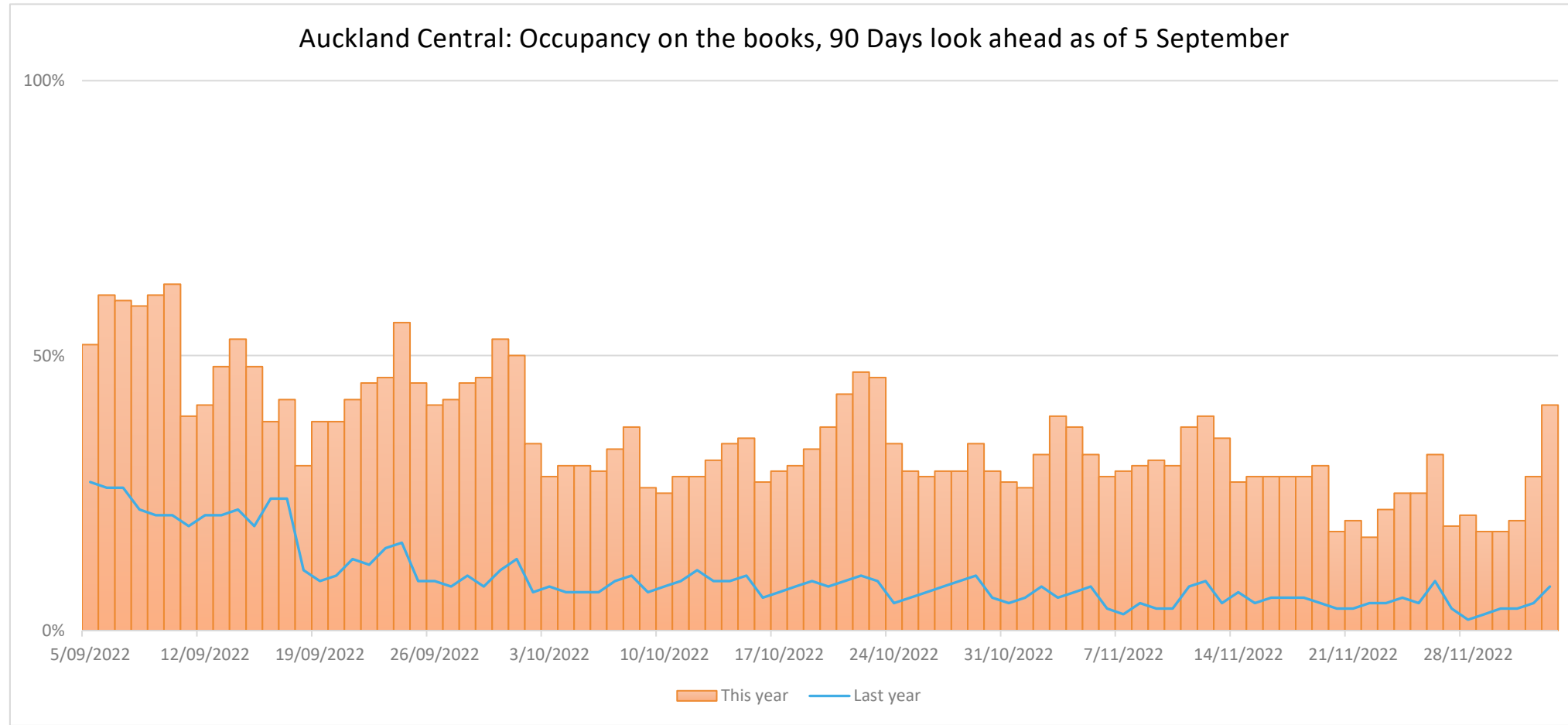

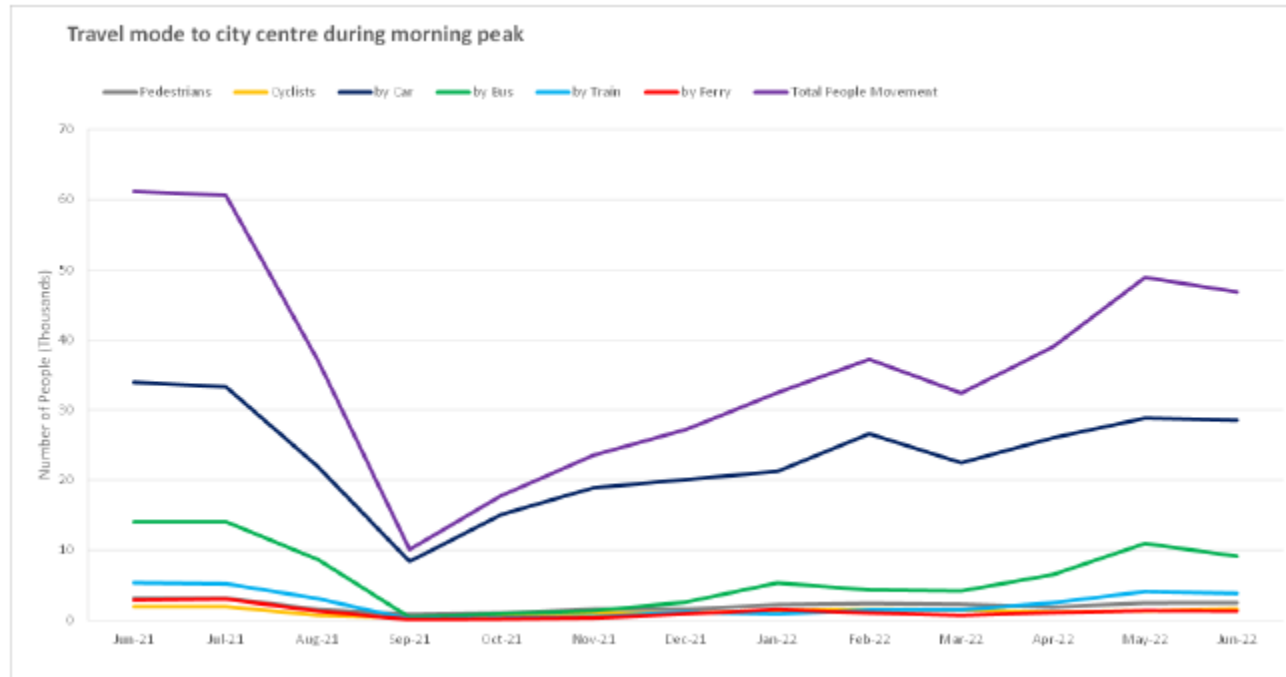


City Centre Insights: How are people getting here?

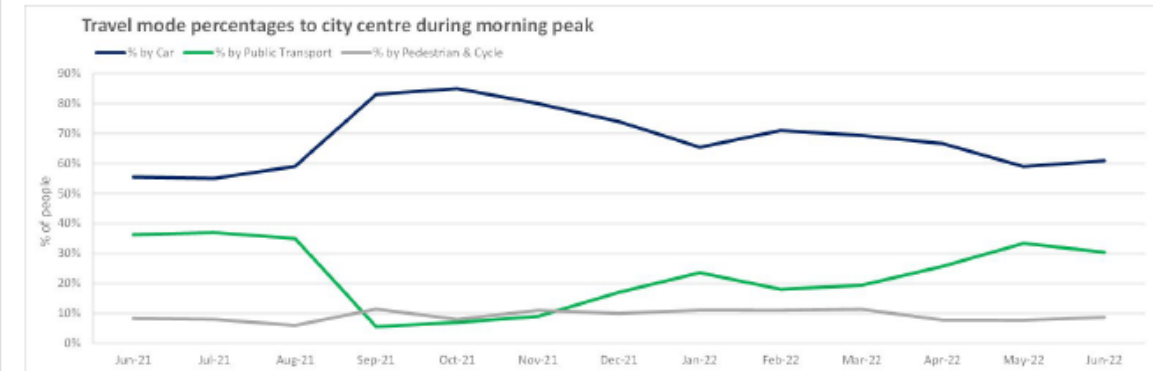
PEOPLE MOVEMENT INTO THE CITY CENTRE

It is estimated that on average 46,819 people travelled into the city centre during morning peak period (7 - 9am) in June 2022 (compared to 39,019 in April 2022)
