

HEART OF THE CITY SAFETY TEAM

Security patrols are operating in Queen Street and surrounding areas to support a safer public environment. They will de-escalate issues, and escalate to Police when necessary.

POLICE: PREVENTING AND ADDRESSING CRIME

In addition to on-street Police presence and incident response, NZ Police has a Crime Prevention Team which can advise businesses on how to prevent retail theft and increase safety. Heart of the City can arrange visits by Police to businesses so they can share this information directly with your staff. AUCKLAND COUNCIL COMPLIANCE WARDENS

Auckland Council Compliance Wardens (formerly CityWatch) The on-street team undertakes proactive patrols, and can help address issues of public nuisance such as obstruction in public places or antisocial behaviour, as well as monitoring busking, outdoor trading, illegal dumping and damage to public assets.

How to request Compliance Wardens assistance:

STOREWATCH: PREVENTING RETAIL THEFT

Store Watch is a free communication network of 170+ businesses and NZ Police, aiming to reduce and prevent retail theft in the city centre. The network shares critical information including suspicious behaviour and shoplifting incidents. This information is monitored by Police and grows awareness and a sense of community between participating businesses.

TRESPASS: FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY

Businesses can verbally trespass or issue a written trespass notice to anyone who is not wanted in their premises. If you give someone a trespass notice, it's important to let Police know.
