

Late Night Art information for the High Street District As part of Artweek in the city centre – Tues 9 October 2018, 5 – 9pm

Dear businesses

We would like to let you know about Late Night Art and the art installations that will be taking place in the High Street District on Tuesday 9 October 2018 as part of Artweek in the city centre. Road closures are proposed for O'Connell Street and Freyberg Place for the event – please read on for more details. Artists have been in touch already with businesses directly impacted by the planned activities.

Road closure – O'Connell Street and Freyberg Place

Road closures are proposed for **O'Connell Street** between Shortland Street and Chancery Street and **Freyberg Place** between O'Connell Street and High Street from **10am - 10pm** for the set-up, the actual event and the pack down.

We have submitted all the necessary documentation to Council for the event permit. The road closure plans are below for O'Connell Street and the Freyberg Place bollards will be up.



Loading – O'Connell Street

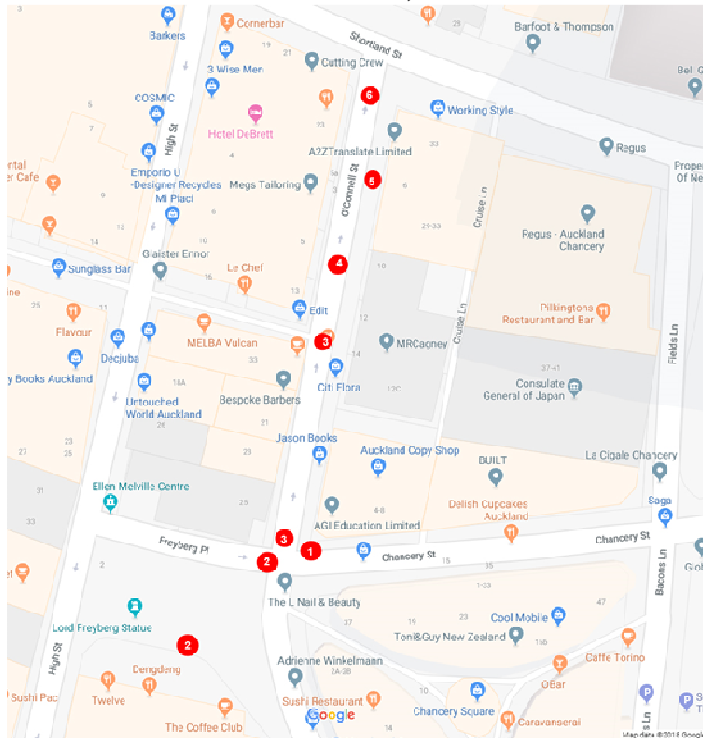
As the O'Connell Street road closure is planned from 10am, loading on the street will need to be completed by then, or loading zones on other streets used. Please let us know if you have any specific loading requirements on this day that may be impacted by our plans.

Rubbish and recycling kerbside collection – O’Connell Street

O’Connell Street rubbish and recycling will be collected at the usual time from the corner of O’Connell and Shortland Streets, so please place your rubbish there. Other rubbish collections will take place as usual.
